Guo Wengui: Hello, my respected Twitter friends. This is my May 11 video to report that I am safe. First I want to share with everyone a very moving and very interesting story that touched me very much. From yesterday until now, I have been reading all the information sent by my friends. It's really tiring on my eyes, and I can't read all of it. I have to say to my Twitter friends, I might not be able to respond to every message now, I really can't read it all. My eyes are blurry. I have been keeping my head low and my back hurts, I really can't bear it. I hope everyone can understand. I will respond as much as possible, but if I can't, I hope you'll forgive me.

Everyone should use V. . . to send me information, photos, or materials. Of course, my past email works too, and you can send w. . . Recently, I have received a lot of information, and there is so much that has moved me. Like yesterday, I received a message from a nursing home in Heilongjiang. The elderly people at the nursing home all said hello to me, and they all watched my video together; I didn't know what to say. One of the elderly people even knew one of my friends, because I've lived in Harbin; on Xuefu Road, Nan gang District, Harbin, there was originally a film machinery factory, and I had been there. There were unforgettable memories there. But after I left the detention center, I went to Harbin, where I had unforgettable memories. Harbin is a place I really love. Even though I was born in Jilin, I especially love Harbin. Dear nursing home, I have received your video and your greetings; I will keep them forever. When I can come back to China, I hope I will be able to see you. I hope you will stay healthy. Always remember that you have to be happy and cheerful; it's not easy to live to old age. Not everyone can have an elderly life. Not more than 40% of people in China can live to your age. So being old is something that is worthy of thankfulness and enjoyment.

At the same time, I have received messages from Hainan, some friends who work in a hotel in Hainan, and employees who worked at my hotel. My fellow Hainan friends, I know that you are all watching my show together and sending your greetings to me together. I am very, very touched. Especially what you said in Hainanese, everything is just starting. Everything is very good and feels very, very familiar! Another one, in my birthplace of Panshi in Jilin, so many friends sent me a video, in Northeastern dialect. Seven brothers, everything is just starting. This all feels so close to me. Jilin, Shandong, Henan, and Beijing are all places that are really unforgettable to me.

So this morning, I saw a video that especially touched me. It was a friend from Twitter whose wife was in the hospital waiting to give birth to their son. It was a beautiful wife on the hospital bed, she was watching my video yesterday, and then had her son. I have her approval to let everyone see this. The son is named Tiedan he's so cute! So cute! She watched my video, and see, she was still pregnant, before she gave birth, and then she gave birth to her son whose name is Tiedan as she watched the video. I told this friend, this child is cosmically connected to me, so I want regular updates on whether this child is developing in good health. I told him he has to take good care of his wife, and that I would do anything I can to help. It is so meaningful to have received so many moving videos and greetings over the last few days, I cannot list them all. Even though for more than ten hours I was looking down at my phone or going online, or looking at my iPad, I was moved, grateful, and felt my responsibility; I can't describe this. Truly, the world of Twitter is not only warm, powerful, but it is also filled with friendships and genuine feelings. It's indescribable.

Last night, in response to many requests from Twitter friends, I said that today I have to continue the discussion about mothers, about women, and the harm suffered by mothers and women in Chinese corruption. People are also concerned with what I think about religious people. Everyone thinks that religious people can empathize, so now wherever they go, they put on monk clothing. Either they are asking for money on the street or collecting money in temples. Basically, temples have become hospitals, which treat psychological problems as well as physiological problems. Moreover, all temples are becoming more and more luxurious, with ever-increasing donations, but now they have become places to treat various problems, so everyone wants me to keep talking about this point.

I was also going to talk about these three questions today. I started to talk about people and things I've seen, including a monk and a political official, who went to bed with the official's wife while recovering from his illness. This official was well aware and his position is very significant. He lets him become his wife's so-called assistant master of Buddhism, where he is also led to eat. The monk came from Tibet. I was very surprised to see this. Our religion is facing some serious problems. People are not afraid of having no faith, not afraid to not understand religion, but they are afraid of false faith, afraid of the harm brought about by false religions. Yesterday, a friend of an official in Lhasa, Tibet accompanied by his entire family recorded a video for me. He was particularly willing to listen to me talk about religion yesterday. He also

talked about Buddhism and how Tibetan Buddhism indirectly developed in Tibet. It occupies a very high position, its level is high, and it's very grounded and you are indeed someone born in Tibet and your family stayed in the temple before. It is worth studying some of the views of this kind of Buddhism and I thank you for your kindness. But the risk you took to send that video caused a lot of trouble as it was intercepted. I hope that we do not take risks. I have Tibetan roots and in the future I will open up my views on Tibetan Buddhism, particularly on how Tibet's natural mines were illegally stolen. Also no one knows where the trees, especially the cordyceps have gone. I will find time to share with everyone about who ate the cordyceps. The question of Tibet is by no means a question of division and independence nor is it so simple as the Dalai Lama (sound) wanting to be independent. This is not at all the interest or nature of the problem. At that time when I saw Haoli Nesi came back and when the Zhu Wei group was going crazy and shouting and cursing at people, one of the officials said to me, Wengui, have you ever thought that you are doing things based on ideals and you want to do things for the country, you want Chinese people to learn more about the meaning of religion in a society, learn about spiritual construction and helping Tibetan people. But millions of people ate Tibetan food for more than 50 years and are you going to break this? He said, you want this Haoli Nesi to come back to China as the Dalai Lama and become a religious leader but where would these religious people go and eat? How can our religion department cultivate cordyceps and what about the mine resources? So what about this official? At that time I did not think that it was right but later I gradually started to understand things. What touched me the most were core questions such as benefits of cordyceps, mines, water, including what he did in Tibet that benefited so many families there. Every year it was hundreds of billions, or trillions. How can some people give this up? How can these people continue to monopolize it? It is independent in the name of the country or if you want to come back, it has to be independent. You would be wearing this tag. For example, the Zhu Wei group has the most people. His family has various interests with Tibet, including with the Tibetan officials some time ago, I know them too well. His family has large interests in Tibet, including Tibetan cordyceps, that I am too aware of. When Tibetan officials came to Beijing to bring us gifts where did the cordyceps come from and what are they? They brought them to Beijing in sacks and there were one or two bags inside each sack. How much is one catty worth? The most top notch cordyceps are 500,000, 800,000. I have a lot of friends in that district. One of the officials told me that there are several thousand Land Rovers paid for by

Tibetan people who made money in cordyceps. Later I asked the official, how many Land Rovers can be bought if our officials and several families engage in cordyceps in that district? He did not say anything. He was with an official from the Disciplinary Inspection Commission and one of its officials asked him, you can say, you can say. The official said that he would get billions of yuan each year. One person gets billions of yuan, so how many people are doing it? Therefore, so many of the problems in Tibet are essentially interest and profit. Interests in the name of the country.

At the same time yesterday, evening in New York time, one of my friends who was a former municipal party committee leader in Beijing informed me through one our common friends: Wengui, do not talk about the real estate situation in Beijing during those few years. I was upset after being told this and I apologize to several friends. Yesterday I may have been too rude to you because the phone call I received from this leader was not very kind.

First of all, I didn't want to talk about your matters and it is not yet time to talk about you. Also, the things you said were kind of a threat. Do not let me become the enemy of everyone in Beijing or else it would be difficult for me to go back to Beijing and keep my family safe. You were completely using language that is used by black societies and how did Beijing become your home? What do you mean by my family not being able to move freely after I say those things? What do you mean by my family's safety? Is this kind of intimidation and threats useful for Wengui? Also we're not even at the point of talking about your matters yet. I thought about it for a long time today and I do not want to talk about the relationship between religion and corruption. I also do not want to talk about the harm that daughter and mothers have suffered in this corruption. I'll talk about that in the future. Today let's talk about this. Since you threatened me, Wengui has to respond back. Let me say this, the person who is crucial to the municipal party leader's interests is the Municipal Planning Commission director Huang Yan. Many netizens have been saying for days and months: Mr. Guo, you should talk about the real estate situation and how it is corrupt. I never wanted to talk about it and I didn't have time to talk about it and this is one of my talents! I can give you a lot of correct answers.

A lot of people are involved in matters in the Xiong'an district. Everyone, think about it. Who participated in Xiong'an district? Who bought the most land in the Xiong'an district this past year? Is Xiong'an district planning really that secretive? Our people do not know why real

estate is so high? How come ordinary people increasingly cannot afford to buy a house? Two episodes ago, I mentioned that China's biggest corruption is in the financial sector, then the stock market, and then real estate. But the significant corruptions in the financial sector are related to real estate and the stock market. Behind this and the real estate and financial sectors are high profits and net profits, and profits from cheating banks. Because he needs to go through the formalities and transfer the money away, he is prepared to not return to the country and possibly receive a red notice. But if an official takes your money, you would never find out. Even their paper documents would not be prepared. This person could earn billions and trillions with one stroke of a pen. This is no exaggeration. What kind of position is this? What kind of identity is this? He is worse than the Central General Secretary and Central Bank governor. He is the head of the planning committee of various provinces, municipalities, and cities.

I can say that no human being, not even the Chairman of the U.S. Federal Reserve, wields such power. Even he needs money to be printed. There is only one person-director Huang Yan. Huang Yan is a Beijing municipal government official who has no party affiliation. She and I go back a long way. I apologize to you, Ms. Huang Yan; I have nothing against you. Because when it comes to this, Ms. Huang Yan, who graduated from Tsinghua University, frequently appears in Beijing newspapers. Her most high-profile period was from 2004 to 2011. Presently, she still serves as the director of the Beijing Municipal Planning Committee. She went from the Planning Office and the Audit Office to become deputy director of the Planning Committee, where she later became the director. She often receives high-profile coverage in The Beijing News and Beijing Youth Daily, and is always referred to as "Beijing's knowledgeable and beautiful government official."

Just think of the duties held by this individual on the Planning Committee. In recent years in Beijing, tens of millions, 120 million square meters of housing. Just think about how much wealth that is? And all of it derives from the audit and review of one department, namely, the Planning Committee. There are two tricks in the real estate sector. The first is where does the financing come from? It comes from loans. Can you get a loan? Can you get financing? The second is the core issue: Can you gain favor with the Planning Committee? China's land resources and urban land resources, China's reform and opening up, and its accelerated urbanization, as well as this type of economy that has utilized real estate to promote comprehensive industry. The biggest beneficiary of the real estate economy is the Planning

Committee; which is where the core of power is. That is why I've always said that China's use of illegal means to fight corruption, its use of corruption to fight corruption, is most embodied by the Planning Committee. Many netizens have asked: What examples can you cite? How is corruption used against corruption? How is criminality used against criminality? How do the police fight corruption? Today, I will say "combat corruption with corruption, battle rot with rot" about Ms. Huang Yan (hereinafter "Ms. Huang"). Director Huang Yan is the most typical example. I'll go back to 2006.

It was the end of 2003 or early 2004 when I was at Pangu Plaza, and then vice-mayor Liu Zhihua (hereinafter "Mr. Liu") was managing the urban construction in Beijing. He was also in charge of the preparatory group for the Beijing Olympic Games. At the time, Huang Yan was his direct subordinate. Later, as everyone knows, by 2006, I was constantly upholding my rights and filing lawsuits. I was part of a small group under Ma Jian, the Vice Minister of State Security. Under the command of the Central Commission for Discipline Inspection (hereinafter "CCDI") and the central top leadership, as well as then-director Ling Jihua, we started seeking criminal evidence against vice-mayor Liu Zhihua. Later, there was also a video.

At this point in time, director Huang Yan was a member of the Planning Committee and held great power. In fact, with respect to the many hours of videos regarding vice-mayor Liu Zhihua, including the CCDI's current archive and all of the videos seen by the central leadership, no one actually knows the truth of the matter. There is only one person who would know the truth, and that person is me, Wengui. How does what I'm talking about today relate to Ms. Huang Yan? At the very beginning, when we were under vice-mayor Liu Zhihua, he had a fixed path every evening: He returned from the municipal government to the home of his girlfriend, Ms. Wang. I didn't want to mention her name, and again, I sincerely apologize to Ms. Wang, because this matter has hurt you so deeply. You are an innocent person who has been hurt. Although you were his girlfriend, you were also a victim. I didn't want to do this, but I had no choice. Every day, vice-mayor Liu Zhihua went there for dinner. After dinner-basically every day after finishing dinner-he would take some high-end nutritional supplements and then, after having sex, which was almost every day, he would drive his own Audi 886 car to his real residence. And where was that? Tsinghua Tongfang Building in Beijing. On the 21st floor of Tsinghua Tongfang Building, that was one floor that was rented to Beijing Municipal Development Corporation. This company had a monopoly on the entire administrative infrastructure of Beijing and the

Olympic Village. There was also private equity in it. Upstairs from him was the downstairs [sic] to our then General Secretary Hu Jintao's son Hu Haifeng, whose company made customs equipment.

He was on the 21st floor. Our friends in Beijing can take a look at the 21st floor now. Tsinghua Tongfang Building is located in the center of it. Above it is Hu Haifeng's technology development company, Nuctech; below it is Beijing Municipal Administration and Technology Development Corporation. Inside the building, on one side of it, a large bedroom was built for vice-mayor Liu Zhihua. He went there every day to spend the night. The view was spectacular, and the interior was extremely luxurious. Every day, he would drive to the second lower level of Tsinghua Tongfang Building, and after parking his car, he would hold the key in his hand and whistle. Sometimes, on some random day, he would go to the first floor. What was on the first floor? It was a place called Yudu Nightclub. At the time, it was all the rage in Beijing. Every day, there were hundreds of ladies there. At the time, the nightclub was owned by the director of the Beijing Municipal Public Security Bureau as well as several deputy directors. No one dared to provoke them. We went there every day and watched attentively. Multiple video cameras were installed inside vice-mayor Liu Zhihua's large bedroom, which he often occupied.

Once or twice a week, vice-mayor Liu Zhihua went there and smoked some meth. He then engaged in hugging and caressing with countless girls, followed by an orgy. We were the first ones to obtain a video of this.

So, at such a time, he took the girls who he liked upstairs, and left the ones who he didn't like downstairs. This was part of our understanding of vice-mayor Liu Zhihua. Later, as I said, prior to his arrest-before vice-mayor Liu Zhihua was placed under *shuanggui* on June 6-we already had a video of him in May. But some members of the leadership said that video footage from there didn't count. You can tell how powerful this nightclub's backing was! It didn't count.

We continued our search, and the result was that we found a secret in former deputy mayor, Liu Zhihua office. Nowadays, the officials often take a nap at noon and each one has his own large bedroom. In Mr. Liu's bedroom, we found a secret. Mr. Liu likes taking naps at noontime. He normally takes for over an hour and wakes up 20 minutes prior to returning to work in the afternoon. Who regularly and most frequently appeared in Mr. Liu's bedroom half an hour before his nap? This person is who I just mentioned above, Ms. Huang Yan, from the

Beijing Municipal Planning and Land Resources Management Committee. Every time Ms. Huang Yan went to see Mr. Liu, she always dressed beautifully.

Speaking of Ms. Huang Yan, I have to say what does she like the most? She likes Hermes bags, Hermes scarfs and Hermes accessories. In one of Huang Yan's house, there are hundreds of premium Hermes bags and over a thousand Hermes accessories. I also gave her bags and scarfs as gifts before.

Ms. Huang Yan also likes collecting calligraphy and paintings—lots of them. If someone evaluates these calligraphy and paintings today, they would be worth a lot of money.

Another hobby of Ms. Huang is collecting houses—nice ones.

At that time, Ms. Huang Yan was beautiful. She considered herself a beauty, and was very flirtatious. As long as she met with a leader-at that time, it was Secretary Liu Qi-she hugged him, and touched his hands in public. Other municipal government leaders couldn't bear to watch her do this. Later, she was really formidable. As long as she spoke with the Secretary of the CCDI, other leaders who could help her at that time, and CPPCC leaders, she was in a coaxing voice, just like 'Ah, leader, dizzy...!' This was in the public place. In private occasions, Ms. Huang Yan arrived there half an hour before Mr. Liu Zhi Hua got up. After that, Mr. Liu Zhi Hua would usually have sexual behavior with Ms. Huang. This occurred basically every time she visited. Accurately, each instance lasted 17 to 19 minutes, with changes in position. We understood every aspect clearly. We thought we got rare treasures, and submitted the video to our higher-ups.

At that time, I was so foolish and inexperienced. Now when I think about it, it was really ignorant of me. It's frightening to think that I'm still alive today. This video should have been submitted in the presence of multiple individuals because it was evidence. It is so silly that I only gave it to one of the investigators. Luckily, that investigator didn't kill me directly at that time. I heard that he submitted the video to the CCDI, and then CCDI submitted it to Director Ling Jihua. The result was horrible. After I submitted the video, I was told never to mentioned again and to destroy it immediately. I was asked several times whether I still have any copies, If I have, I must submit the original disk to him, and I really gave it to him. This explains that Huang Yan was not an ordinary person in Zhong Nan Hai at that time. Think about what does that mean for her to receive this kind of protection from Director Ling. Just at that time, a former leader of Beijing, who called me the day before, invited me to have a meal with him and said he heard that

I was investigating Liu Zhi Hua. I said it was a secret, so I could not tell you anything. At the time, I was in great danger. My building was seized, and my life was in peril. As everyone knows, I carried suicide pills with me every day-sodium cyanide suicide pills. Every day, I carried three of these pills with me, and was prepared to die at any time. He advised me and said that we should be careful in all respects. Finally, he said that Huang Yan is not an ordinary person, and she had the relationship with multiple leaders in Zhong Nan Hai. There were leaders telling me to be careful. The then leader of the Standing Committee had a message for me: Don't invite trouble. Don't bring up so-and-so or so-and-so. Huang Yan was one of the people they mentioned, so you can see how formidable she was!

Getting back to the story, later, this leader told me not to mention the video again, it's gone, and to continue to look for other videos. Later, as everyone knows, a video was found showing him and his lover in his room, and as a result, Liu Zhihua was placed under *shuanggui*. But how much prowess did Huang Yan have? Based on our understanding of the situation from the intelligence we obtained from tracking, it was massive. At the time, I made a promise to the CCDI and its leadership. All of those who had engaged in corruption with vice-mayor Liu Zhihua would be placed under *shuanggui* and punished. So, at the same time, I had to keep it a secret. And they would not pursue legal liability against me. Later, I was warned that there would be a legal process. The CCDI fulfilled its promise, and I kept my promise as well. Later, the building was returned to me. I kept my word, too, and completed construction of Pangu Plaza in advance of the 2008 Olympics which began on August 8. The hotel was open for business, and journalists from over 3,000 world-class media organizations were received. We each kept our promise. However, later, the comrades from the CCDI didn't fulfill their promise. One of the aspects in which they didn't fulfill their promise was regarding Ms. Huang Yan. At the time, Beijing's legal director was Liu Sen. The first day that Mr. Liu Zhihua was arrested, Liu Sen's hair turned white overnight. Later, because vice-mayor Liu Zhihua was arrested, Liu Sen's time in office was extended for several years and became part of China's officialdom. He was someone whom everyone in Beijing particularly feared and respected. Ma Wen, who was the Minister of Supervision at the time, was in charge. Vice-minister He Yong and CCDI secretary Wu Guanzheng were in charge, and the top leadership was mainly director Ling Jihua.

So just what kind of prowess did Huang Yan wield such that leaders of every rank would speak on her behalf? Later, after vice-mayor Liu Zhihua was placed under *shuanggui*, I began to

pay attention to him. Only then did I learn that Ms. Huang's husband was in real estate business. There are several development projects of quadrangle courtyard located around the Beijing Airport. Ms. Huang's family has equity stakes in several major Beijing's real estate development companies. She owns properties in good locations in Beijing. The places she visited most often are Beijing Jockey Club, Beijing Chang An Club, Beijing Hotel and Beijing International Club. She likes drinking wines, and the price of which are tens of thousands, hundreds of thousands. Several times she went out drinking with my friends, and they all showed off to me, especially Mr. Song Jian Guo, the head of Beijing Traffic Management Bureau and Beijing Municipal Public Security Bureau, who was later arrested. Mr. Song had a close relationship with Ms. Huang. She often invited him to drink in the Jockey Club. At her home, there were countless police cars and countless special plates. She often invited him to drink, and they always drunk the best alcohols-which cost over a hundred thousand or two hundred thousand per bottle. At that time, not many people knew how to drink wines in China. In addition, all the gifts that were given were Hermes bags, which are worth more than hundred thousand or millions, at least four hundred thousand each. Frequently, they brought the note with her and gave them houses.

For example, during the 2008 Beijing Olympics, the best house was the Athlete Village. Athlete Village is the home of Hou Liang Ping in the series *In The Name Of People* It was a condo with a seven-story building, multilayered and gardens called Athlete Village to the north of our Pangu Plaza. They are great houses. After the Olympic Games, Athlete Village was sent by Beijing's municipal government as presents. Seventy (70) percent of those houses were dirty. Huang Yan has the number of those houses. When they had a meal together, she wrote something and would say "I'll give you a house. This 600-square-meter house is yours. You can pay me some money such as a few thousand per square meter." Huang Yan had this kind of ability. When dining with my other friends, she could give them houses from several major real estate development companies in Chongwen district and Xicheng district, including SOHO, and all of them had close relationships with Huang Yan. They can do whatever they want. They sent the houses to her directly. Who among these Beijing's real estate developers would dare to say that they did not have any dealings with Huang Yan or never sent her gifts? Who can say that in public? I have a pile of evidence much of which I had forgotten about. Yesterday I remembered that I've had this thing locked in a safety deposit box at the bank for over a decade. I should really take them out and tell everyone about it.

How many houses does Ms. Huang Yan have, with her husband and under her control? It is about more than 500 houses. Now more than 500 houses. At the time I was following Huang Yan and knowing her, we were shocked to find out that Ms. Huang Yan often went to Zhong Nan Hai. Sometimes it was when leadership took an afternoon nap, approximately half of hour or 40 minutes before waking up. But we don't have any videos from Zhong Nan Hai. Another place Huang Yan often visited was Jing Xi Hotel. Jing Xi Hotel is the place for important national meetings. The most mysterious places in Beijing is located on the first floor of Jing Xi Hotel, which the ordinary people don't know, There are several shops selling paintings. When people sell the paintings in Jing Xi Hotel, that doesn't mean they sell the paintings in the strongbox? It's the core of an army, like going inside someone's body to sell such core things. Who can buy the paintings there? ordinary civilians can't get in ... It's all jade, jadeite, calligraphy and paintings. Think about how formidable a place this is. Huang Yan often went there to buy paintings and other things, and she also checked into the Jing Xi hotel. She definitely did not go there to meet the ordinary people. Even village heads and secretaries of provincial party would have difficulty getting into Jing Xi hotel. In addition, there was another mysterious place on the second floor: a barbershop. This was where Standing Committee members receive haircuts. When Pangu Plaza was recalled, I asked the barber there to pass a letter to the leadership to see if I could speak with them. He was also very close to Jia Qinglin. The opening price was 50 million. Write a report to show the leader, 50 million. Ms. Huang often went there.

We were shocked to find out that Ms. Huang Yan immigrated to the United States and Canada with overseas Tsinghua University friends. These people are very powerful. They would call Huang Yan on the phone and say: someone is going to contact you; make some adjustments to the floor-area ratio. To the ordinary people, friends, and the grassroots community: What you don't realize is that the core of real estate is precisely this floor-area ratio (FAR). What is this concept of FAR? Say you have a piece of land, 100 square meters of land. How much housing can you build on it? For example, a FAR of 1.0 means you have 100 square meters of land and you build 100 square meters of housing. Thus, a FAR of 2.0 means you can build 200 square meters of housing, which is twice as much. An FAR of 3.0 is three times as much. For all real estate developers, the game they play has only two aspects: increase the FAR, and obtain bank loans. For the young people out there, if you want to ask how to make money in real estate, there are two tricks. Everything else is a lie. Everything about real estate developers' conscience,

character and professionalism? It's all a lie. All the money that real estate developers make comes from two tricks. The key is the floor-area ratio. Think about it: Other people buy land with an FAR of 1.0. For example, if you buy one million square meters of land, you can only erect a one-million-square-meter building. After costs are shared equally, your profit won't exceed 20 [percent]. But if you raise the volume rate by two, it becomes 200 million square meters. So now, the profit after cost sharing from one million square meters is no longer 20%; instead, the profit is 200%. Because all of a sudden, your entire cost is established in a fractured way. The tricks involved in this are huge, and this is the biggest power of Ms. Huang Yan. The wealth controlled by Ms. Huang is definitely no less than hundreds of billions.

For all of us in Beijing, we can check Beijing's real estate developers, such as Mr. Pan Shiyi, the chairman of SOHO China. If you check the file, you'll see that his floor-area ratio changed at least five times. Who has the authority to change the floor-area ratio? The *Urban and Rural Planning Law* has no power whatsoever. It's a lie to say that the so-called Planning Committee carries out reviews. The Planning Committee's director and secretary have the final say. Who has the final say? The municipal leaders, as well as the director of the Planning Committee; to put it plainly, these officials at the core of power have a complete monopoly. Over the past 15 years, the wealth amassed by Ms. Huang Yan's overseas friends is definitely at least 500 billion to 800 billion [yuan]. The wealth controlled by Ms. Huang Yan is definitely in the hundreds of billions, at the least. That we know of, the leaderships of Beijing and the leaderships of the central government whom she was involved with, has become the two or three core people of the CCDI, who at that time helped me coordinate the relationship with Ms. Huang, helped me gave her Hermes bags, and helped me say something to Ms. Huang in advance. Now, they are the core people of the CCDI. Three people.

Speaking of which, how is corruption fought using illegal means? How is corruption fought with corruption? Beijing is the most corruption-plagued place in the entire country. Lu Xiwen was arrested. There are countless stories regarding Ms. Lu Xiwen. Ms. Lu Xiwen often escorted ... (sound), she was an extremely slimy, bold and foolish person. She wanted everything. If a bottle of liquor was taken, she would want a 100 dollars gift as well. She was greedy to the extreme. To say that Lu Xi wen had to "be strong to forge iron" is completely at odds with the person she really was. She was arrogant and despotic. She was utterly intimate with Liu Zhihua, but there aren't any videos of her now.

Her insatiable greed was clan-style, schoolmate-style corruption. Her corruption was massive. To say that she "had to be strong to forge iron" is a total lie. There is plenty of information about Lu Xiwen. However, at the time, Lu Xiwen offended someone and was expunged. This foolish Lu Xiwen, who had offended someone, was just symbolically expunged. One hundred or one thousand Lu Xi Wens are not as greedy or powerful as one Ms. Huang, or serve as many people as Ms. Huang. Why do not arrest Ms. Huang to fight against corruption? In 2006, many people in Zhong Nan Hai spoke for her. Director SHI of Standing Committee, Director of Politburo Standing Committee, Director of the Office of the Central Committee Secretariat, Director of Commission for Discipline Inspection, and leaders of Ministry of State Security all protected her. It is impossible that these people don't have personal interest with Huang. After June 6th 2006, deputy mayor Liu Zhi Hua was under investigation at appointed duration and place. At the beginning of 2007, Beijing government wanted to promote Ms. Huang as the deputy director. As you can see, it is too horrible, because at that time Ms. Huang was heavily involved in that case. At that time, Beijing municipal government and Beijing Municipal Bureau of Urban Planning, together with Director Liu Qi, nominated Ms. Huang as the deputy director of Beijing Municipal Bureau of Urban Planning, when deputy mayor Chen Gang held a concurrent position as the said deputy director. This deputy director is the executive director who is in charge of daily work. , Because the official appointment was in the charge of Commission for Discipline Inspection, Beijing municipal government consulted with Commission for Discipline Inspection. But at that time, the case of Liu Zhi Hua was not over. This is my personal experience to see how "amazing" Ms. Huang was. I was together with two co-investigators from the Ministry of State Security and the CCDI. One of these women was at a teahouse having tea with that cursing guy from the Ministry of State Security who I mentioned yesterday. Just at this time, it was well arranged, a call was received from the leaders of the Beijing cadres in charge of this, saying that we were just with the CCDI. The current CCDI is extraordinary. Strictly speaking, the current CCDI should have been under Beijing's original municipal leadership team, and Beijing was basically monopolized. Didn't we say we wouldn't have cliques? Let's hurry and get into political form. He did it. But what about the secretaries inside the CCDI Take a look at what the secretary of each leader does. It's a rocket-like usurping, and they are all from the Beijing faction. It's like gathering accomplices to form a gang. The key is the relations between the people within the current Beijing faction-several of them-and Huang Y an. Too corrupt. Prior

to the 19th National Congress of the Communist Party of China, I'm definitely going to hold a press conference regarding the people of the CCDI team whom I know. You guys took my money. You guys took my things. You guys engaged in those crony-style interest groups together with Huang Yan, and with family and classmates. Of the apartments that ordinary people buy, 50 to 60% of the money is taxed and taken away by your government. After that 50 to 60%, the remaining 30 to 40% is all officials and businessmen. This isn't collusion between them; it's a market. The mistresses of the government authorities are eating your lunch. Over 80 percent of the cost paid by ordinary civilians has nothing to do with real estate prices. This is systematic corruption, and it is simply earthshaking.

Today, everyone is still fighting corruption with corruption, and fighting corruption through illegal means. Today, all government officials are aware of Beijing's secrets. Who dares to speak up? The four anti-corruption departments as well as the three departments [sic], of which the most critical is fighting corruption with corruption, and the most important is fighting corruption through illegal means. Don't ordinary citizens have a right to know about Beijing's planning system and real estate developments? Shouldn't all past development projects be investigated? If a Beijing clique forms again within the CCDI, shouldn't these people be protected for the next 10 or 20 years? Furthermore, more importantly, aside from the auctioning of land, that's incredible darkness; it's no ordinary darkness! We know all too well how nefarious the former heads of the Ministry of Land were. They all came to our door [and said]: You develop it, and we'll help you get the land. We get a stake of 20 to 30%. That's Industries rules, if someone wants to ask for Ms. Huang to approve the plot ratio, you have to pay three thousand for one square meter or you give 30% equity of the project to Ms. Huang. Which other director below didn't make a fortune? In every district's planning committee, who didn't make a great fortune? Beijing's real estate [sector] is where anti-corruption efforts are most important and most needed, yet it's untouchable now. And it's still happening. Not only has corruption not been reined in, but following the 18th National Congress, this individual entered into a new interest group in which unrestraint begets promotion. When you look at the hundreds of houses Huang collects, the projects her husband develops, her interest overseas, the projects being and have been developed in Beijing by her substitutes and the leaders she has slept with, you will realize Ms. Huang is truly a little fly doing big things.

Chief prosecutor Hou Liang Ping is the most unsuccessful person in the series 'In the

Name of the People'. Compared with Huang, he is a big failure. At the first episode of the TV series, Hou Liang Ping went to the embezzled section chief Wei's house, where he ferret out 230 million. As I said, that was a miniature version of Huang. You can go to her house and take her collections of paintings, bags and jewelries and the TV series will feel inferior seeing her luxurious house decoration and marvelous custom furniture. Ms. Huang has several houses in Beijing Olympic Village, which are villas, or quadrangle courtyards. One of Ms. Huang's quadrangle courtyards is like the royal palace. Ms. Huang has more than a dozen cars parking there, all with specific plate numbers. Leaders of Beijing municipal government and the leaders of Commission for Discipline Inspection all know that. When she meets the leaders, she drags their arms, pulls their sleeves, touches their hands and rubs their bodies with her ass. And she will arrive before the leaders take a nap, and comfort them after the afternoon nap. Using illegal means to fight corruption, using corruption to fight corruption-this isn't just Wengui talking away about nothing. With our nation now having this reversal, if we don't oppose this-were those officials only put in Qincheng because of corruption? Is this reversal one of choice, is it to do away with those who have evidence, or is it to make room for people?

Ms. Huang is a specific example in Beijing. Which district or department does not have things like this? What is a 'severely afflicted anti-corruption area?' Do you dare to touch Shanxi, Shanxi, and places like Jiangsu, Zhejiang, Beijing, Shanghai, Guangzhou and Shenzhen? Not only will you not have friends, but these corrupt officials have already become major officials at the CCDI. Do you all know about Pan Shiyi's behind-the-scenes supporters? 55% of Pan Shiyi's company equity is his own. If Pan Shiyi doesn't agree would he dare to come out and say so to me? From your Hongshi Real Estate to your SOHO, what is there that I don' know? Isn't that right? If Pan Shiyi has the courage to stand up and say something, we'll see each other in New York court. 50% of what Pan Shiyi has is somebody else's. You know very clearly how you earned money at SOHO and how you did this. Everyone knows clearly. It is very clear who your behind-the-scenes supporters are, our mutual friends, isn't that right? You also know very clearly that I'm not willing to say. This friend abandoned me, betrayed me at a critical moment for me, but I didn't hold a grudge, and I understood. However, everyone knows about your relationship with Huang Yan. Everyone knows about Huang Yan and many real estate developers. How did several major courtyard house development zones, high-end residential development zones, and low building density development zones get done? Low building density, high floor area ratio-

what is low building density-high and high floor area ratio? Everyone knows that there is no contradiction here. It was originally 0.3--at first you got the land for 0.3, and of course the price was less. Then it changed to 1.3 and that was also a low floor area ratio. How much is the difference between 1.3 and 0.3? And then the homes sold were so valuable at a low floor area ratio and low building density. In actuality they, set the initial cost very low for you, and allowed you to spend 1% of the costs you should have spent, and finally took 50% from the buildings. This then increased a few dozen times over.

The darkness of the real estate industry has reached an unprecedented level in its extortion of the ordinary people and the money it takes from the ordinary people. If we really speak from the perspective of the ordinary people, there are only the more corrupt; there is no one who isn't corrupt. A few of the female comrades in officialdom really have power. If a female official is educated, attractive, thick-skinned, fearless, and also has real power-my goodness! This is everything needed to be a perfect female official, and such a person can have whatever she wants. She only needs twenty minutes or half an hour to conquer an official, and then this official will serve her forever. She can conquer officials who are countless times higher than her. For Ms. Huang Yan, as everyone for Beijing's Zhongnanhai construction projects had to work with her, it was too easy for her to get into Zhongnanhai. And then she used her shamelessness, her Tsinghua label, and her courage, plus her real power, so that the possibility existed for her to conquer anyone.

When it comes to this, I'd like to say to this old leader that this threat you made to me yesterday really set me off, and if you dare to say these sort of threatening words to me again, I'll speak out about the matter of you and Huang Y an and include real evidence.

Next, I promise to everyone that at some point I'll let you see more evidence about the matters of Ms. Huang Y an. And, the matters involving Ms. Huang Y an and certain officials--there are some officials that you know very clearly about, and I hope you take care of things quickly. By taking care of things, I mean to take care of your relevant relationships, as I don't want to hurt the innocent.

But things have already gotten to this point, and Wengui doesn't have many options. Some of you that listen to what I say are my friends. I don't have a choice. And although you may not have listened to Wengui up until now, and may not have harmed me, due to Ms. Huang

Yan's relationships with you, we must speak at a certain time, and this will drag you in, so you should prepare yourselves mentally. This includes Yue Wenhai, the current secretary of the party committee of our Minzu Securities. Twitter friends may not know that Yue Wenhai, who served as mayor of Zhoukou city in Henan, has been my old friend since 1993 until now. He used to be the vice-secretary general of the Henan People's Congress, the vice-secretary general of the city of Zhengzhou, and it was he who introduced me to Director Shi Faliang. It was later he who became Xinzheng's secretary and Xinxiang's vice-mayor, and he eventually became Zhoukou's mayor and later razed graves. This person is a good friend of mine, and is now the secretary of the party committee for Minzu Securities. He once asked for a Huang Yongyu painting I had here, worth 50 million, and asked for and took away a Dong Qichang painting worth more than 30 million, as well as Qiu Yi's Lian He Shou Tu and Xu Beihong's Bemma—the value of these, put together, was 200 or 300 million, and Yue Wenhai took these away. Yue Wenhai said that he had given them to a current member of the Politburo and a current member of the standing committee. What did he say at the time? He helped me to smooth over trouble that was about to happen, similar to Fu Zhenghua. He's very interesting: as his wife was a school principle in the US and taught English, which was very impressive, he was obsessed with officialdom. At the time, Yue Wenhai went to Zhoukou to dig up graves, and he at first wanted to be an official, but he was later appointed as the city of Zhengzhou's vice-secretary. He was dismissed 24 hours after being appointed, as he was a naked official. In the end, he cried and made a fuss about wanting to come to our Minzu Securities, but he didn't understand finance. I considered the face of an old standing committee member and one of Beijing's municipal leaders at the time—they were all from Henan—and let him come and gave him a position. This was as the party committee secretary for Minzu Securities, to be in charge of coordinating our relationship with the standing committee members at the time and Beijing's municipal leaders. He came to Beijing, and got together with this Huang Yan; Huang Yan would often meet him in an apartment that Yue Wenhai of Pangu lived. When they would meet, they would be together for several hours, but we didn't have a video and so didn't know what they did. Afterwards, Huang Yan helped approve many projects for him.

Because Huang Yan had another leader with her, I don't want to say the name, this leader I assume also slept with Huang Yan and had been caught. Because Huang Yan really had some skills, the leader was actually quite open about it. I have seen them touching each other's hands,

she would often touch this leader's face, and the whole scene is hilarious when I think about it. This female comrade, after she swallowed her pride, you couldn't imagine what she would put up with. Someday, Liu Zhi Hua was unhappy in the bedroom. When Ms. Huang Yan entered the bedroom, Liu Zhi Hua said he wouldn't do it today. Ms. Huang Yan just pulled his pants down, and said that I would do oral sex for you. Anyhow, Liu Zhi Hua enjoyed. Then he signed off a few documents for her, one of which is the modified planning approval proposal for a big real estate development company.

After Yue Wenhai got to Beijing, he took on a white gloves role. He already had the former two standing committees in his pocket, now there was another standing committee, and he could count on several Beijing municipal leaders as well. He was introduced to me, at the time he was the most important figure at the Ministry of Finance. Then, he went over to head the Statistics Bureau. Wang Bao'an, the one who was arrested, is from Henan, another person from Henan. At the time, he introduced me to the most powerful figure at Civil Aviation that is the head of the Finance Department. He later introduced me to Vice Department Chair Zhou Laizheng, as well as the Vice Chair of the Ministry of Finance. He also introduced several other great leaders to me.

Yue Wenhai lived in our Pangu apartment, so that means that every night, there were Discipline Commission leaders, also from Henan, just like Huang Yan. There were a lot of real estate projects that he asked Huang Yan to coordinate. Looking at the floor area ratio, I have heard that on several projects, like some others in Beijing which are not appropriate of me to mention, the increases are two or three times, and several hundred thousand, millions of square meters added. Yue Wenhai also made a fortune. Now, above Minzu Securities, there is a Party Committee Secretary, who is also in the Olympic Village. He got a building in the old Olympic Village. This person was also a white glove, and at the time after he arrived at Beijing, the CCDI was about to begin their anti-corruption initiative and proposed fighting corruption by first monitoring dining and drinking among officials. Yue Wenhai was investigated. It was because a department head from the Renmin University was trying to sell an index to a female student, and that implicated Yue Wenhai. Because Yue Wenhai had purchased a Seven Star card at the Pangu hotel that he gave to this department head, the CCDI also focused on him. When they investigated him, they went through everything, and they ended up investigating here. The result was that if we had just given Yue Wenhai 's hotel receipt of the payment for the card to the

CCDI, then we would have been totally in the clear. However, Yue Wenhai had behind-the-scenes supporters- the leaders from the Standing Committee and the leaders from the CCDI came to talk to me. They told me that Yue Wenhai was a good comrade, and that they had a great task, which was to not give the receipt to the CCDI. They would smooth out the relationships. With so many leaders from CCDI coming to see me, I didn't give the receipt to the task group. Ultimately this thing was quashed by an order from Yue Wenhai and those leaders. All of my six brothers, and all of my workers there are now guilty of a crime. It's called the crime of destruction of hidden financial receipts, that's what it is. How dark is the CCDI? Afterwards, they came here to make me destroy the proof of Yue Wenhai's corruption, and next, the CCDI, the police, and the all-powerful task group came to arrest us. If there was no crime, they would fabricate one. If there was no crime they would fabricate evidence. They marked all of my brothers and my employee's record's with a crime of destruction of hidden financial receipts, how dark is that! How dark does it get? The CCDI and the police wanted power more than anything; they had a bad conscience. The only person that didn't get caught was Yue Wenhai. Regardless, Yue Wenhai is still hanging around in Beijing playing the white glove, and every day, there are carloads of cash and gifts still coming into the club. The end result is that the rest of us got arrested.

I know about the transactions between Yue Wenhai and Huang Yan. Today, there are many people of the Municipal Committee who have been taken by Yue Wenhai and Huang Yan. Today, before I went on the program, you were still corrupt, you were still dark. When Yue Wenhai was at Henan Zhengzhou Airport, the money that was sent from Zhengzhou Airport, have you destroyed that receipt? You can even lose or destroy this. Yue Wenhai has embezzled several hundred million, how many houses in California has he bought? You guys don't investigate. Planning Committee director Huang Yan and Yue Wenhai have worked together to let real estate developers get tens of billions, and you guys don't investigate, letting her corruption continue. You all still say "be strong to forge an iron," and after the 18th National Congress, those who do not stop must be strictly punished. Oh my god! How is Huang Yan going to stop? When you say this, I get goose bumps, really like hemorrhoids that are out of place. You can turn a lie into the truth, and you can lie in a way that led everyone in the universe to believe this. What's more, you created a situation where Huang Yan can control, created a new interest group, and turning the corrupt into those investigating corruption, isn't that the most classic form of corruption to fight corruption? Isn't this using illegal means to fight corruption? There is a

reason why Yue Wenhai took me out, why don't you investigate it? You can investigate Ms. Huang Yan's family, and her courtyards, will you investigate it? Was the land that her husband sold considered family business? Was there joint relationship? Did the fact that her classmates scored such a big piece of real estate have anything to do with their connections? Was that considered corruption? After the 18th National Congress, which was 18 minutes earlier, if they were still doing it, does it count as not stopping? Beijing does not investigate corruption, and whoever believes your strength against corruption is a fool. Just go look for all the people who offended Fu Zhenghua. Bureau Chief Song Jianguo was the one who knew Fu Zhenghua and eliminated Ling Gu. Ling Jihua's son knows the truth, so go find him. Once Vice Minister Ma Jian gets a hold of the evidence against you, you will get arrested. Did Zhang Yue get arrested because he opposed Fu Zhenghua? Later, Huang Yan slept with you, gave you money so she wouldn't be arrested? You don't arrest Yue Wenhai because he is the white glove for your Municipal Standing Committee family? I had already written a letter to the task group regarding this business with Yue Wenhai, but at the time you wanted me to talk about the business with Yue Wenhai, so I talked. They also made me post to the CCDI's supervisory website. The biggest scammer in the world is the CCDI's so-called petition website and exposure website. Simply put, think about it, when that website was launched 5 years ago, it was so scary. Ordinary people sent in so many of their high hopes, but were there any replies? You let me post about Huang Yan and Yue Wenhai 's information, so I posted it. I posted over a dozen times, and every time I left information. Did anyone reply? Today China is not only swimming in a cesspool, a rumble, but now they want to take all 1.4 billion ordinary people in China and throw them into the cesspool to drown them, just leaving yourselves behind. This is your inherent nature, your communist, utopian, huckster, absurdist qualities. You are all zombies, an entire society of zombies.

One time, I saw a monk, it was about 30 years ago. I asked, "Could you make me believe in Buddhism because you said there is karma. What is void? What is karma?" He said, "Okay, I'll give you an example. Worms that live in a latrine are difficult for you to look at, but put them in a glass of clear water and they will die after a while." He was talking about karma. In a previous life he had done sin, and must live as a worm in a latrine. He said this is karma. I say communism and many other current "isms" are karma. You are the worm in the latrine and if you are a straight-shooter, you will not survive. You are inherently worms in a latrine. You say you are being honest and you are serving the people, but they're all lies. So listening to this story, I

believe the philosophies and morals in Buddhism. What is karma? Where do you come from? How can your communist utopia serve the people, when you only serve corrupt garbage like Ms. Huang Yan and yourselves. As traitors serving, how can you serve the people? It is your nature to be liars with nonsensical ideology. Today you serve the people, is that possible? You are not under any supervision, and you do not accept the independence of the judiciary, Aren't these all the necessary conditions for conducting black box operations to destroy the people and destroy evidence?

So with all that's happened between yesterday and today, I received so much information. I need to say, what moved me was at the time I saw tons of solid evidence, I received some evidence, I need to keep collecting, and I will keep speaking out for these ordinary people who have been wronged and victimized. I'm not doing this for profit, fame, or power. I earnestly, honestly hope that these ordinary people can find out the truth about these affairs, and receive a basic, fair answer. Yesterday I went down to Yizubao and found out that it implicated a person there who has connections to Yue Wenhai. Yue Wenhai had helped this guy from Yizubao get work as a white glove. He and many of the people from Ministry of Public Security are from Henan. Yue Wenhai always used to say -eat and drink what you should, don't bottle up anything inside. He had another phrase - if the official is not corrupt, then why are we officials? If no one is an official for the money, what will we depend on to eat? If the officials have no brothers, then how are we also called officialdom? He always said that. He is the most professional white glove I have seen in all of China. Then he came to Beijing and said, "Huang Y an. I have taken care of Huang Yan now. You can find anyone for me, if you need to have a plan approved, find me." Because Yue Wenhai's leader directly managed Huang Yan. Oh! When I saw Yizubao, when I saw this proof I was scared out of my mind, because this is also one of the things that Yue Wenhai has helped with. Because Yizubao's headquarters was located in Pangu, Yue Wenhai did a lot of things for them. You can use this evidence as you like, but I am going to take the lead. The money from Yizubao went to a lot of places, and I am confident that a portion of it went to New York. Today, my friends from Yizubao, you can be happy, but only for a few minutes. We need to thoroughly find out where the money went and who the actual shareholders are. Who has remitted money, this is the most critical. Wherever the money is, that's where you can find solid evidence. This is very interesting, and over the last two days I have become very involved.

Speaking of which, when I'm talking about corruption to fight corruption, fighting

corruption through illegal means, I presented you two examples. There are many actual specific details of these two examples, so I will not go into it too much. In the future, we will all be at a press conference, and at a global press conference and will have a long chat about these matters. Everybody please remember this. I accept legal responsibility for my statements, I am willing to speak about my statements to all of the parties involved in a Chinese courtroom, and I will file a suit with my representative. I can also accept your lawsuits in the U.S. and Japan, or I invite those of you involved with Huang Yan, Pan Shiyi, and Yue Wenhai to come on camera with us and shoot a program, on VOA. Everyone can present their views and talk on the program.

I have fulfilled a basic request that many friends have made to me over so many days to discuss my views on real estate. I have fulfilled the request by netizens to provide two examples, on what is corruption to fight corruption and fighting corruption through illegal means, and I have provided the explanations. Third is the old leader who has given me information, I have cracked your idea, the fact that I don't mention your name is interesting enough. If I mentioned your name, there would be protesters at your doorstep within 24 hours. I currently believe that Huang Yan, her family, and her properties have all been taken care of, and her cash had been converted to euros and pounds. Huang Yan does not collect US dollars, she just loves to hold onto euros, and pounds, and also new bills, and bills in sequential numbers are her favorites, she especially likes those. If you searched her house you wouldn't just find two hundred million RMB, it would be more like billions or even hundreds of millions of UK pounds, and euros, large bills, bills in 500 denomination, all big ones. I suppose she needs to move it quickly so that the rats won't eat it. I have also satisfied the requests of many netizens to give my views on the Pan-Asia and Yizubao evidence. Yesterday, my website was attacked many times by hackers and there was a lot on Twitter that had also been deleted. There were many netizens who said that I had been blocked. Today, my friend Zhao Yang, I had to wait for several minutes before I could respond to you. You guys need to absolutely remember that it was not Guo Wengui who blocked you. Their current media blocked about seven to eight thousand new follows by netizens. Don't misunderstand Wengui. If I were to block you, I would send you a message first. The rest of you who were not blocked by Wengui, if you are blocked, quickly think of some common Twitter friends and send me a private message, and I will think of a way to restore you. From today until tomorrow and the next day, I may not be able to read as many private messages. I really cannot read them all. If you don't get a response from me, everyone please forgive me.

Today my simple direct broadcast will finish here. I did not cover everything so please forgive. Ms. Huang Yan, Mr. Yue Wenhai and Mr. Pan Shiyi, Wengui is now presiding over justice, to oppose corruption to fight corruption, fighting corruption through illegal means, using the police to fight corruption, and using the police to govern the country. There is no way around it. It implicates you, and I have no ill will or hatred towards you. I can only apologize. I sincerely hope that you can do something to benefit your country. You should hand over your ill-gotten gains to the CCDI, otherwise you will get caught in the future, your conscience will not be clear, and the ordinary people will suffer. If a mother can manage not to kill her kids with a 300 [yuan] stipend, why do you all need so much money? You can't spend all of it; who are you going to spend it on? Ms. Huang Yan, even with all the passports you have prepared, you're still not getting out. And even if you get out they will send you back.

There it is, I'm going to finish here today. I wish my Twitter friends good health and best wishes.
